

Quick Guide - ARchitect Mobile Viewer



Installation

The ARchitect Mobile Viewer (AMV) can be installed using two different methods

- Over the air (OTA)
- Sideload from the ADK

We're going to explain OTA installation only as is the easier and faster to accomplish. There are 3 steps to get AMV running on your Android device.

Step 1: Configure your Android device

Most Android devices won't let you install applications outside Android market. However you can easily allow other install sources than Android market in your Settings.

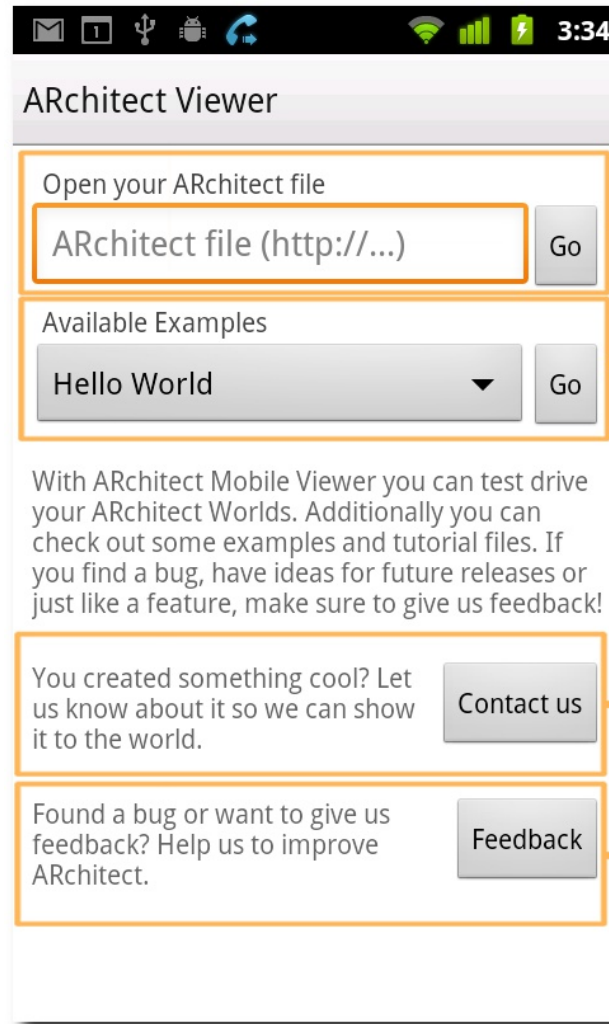
- Open the *Settings* menu
- Look for *Applications* and open this menu
- Enable *Unknown sources* and confirm the security message

Step 2: Download the file

Open the browser on your phone and go to:

Step 3: Install AMV

After downloading open the file and AMV will install automatically. Now you will find AMV in your applications menu. Launch it and give it a try!
