

Published between 1969 and 1991 in 14 volumes, 30 parts, 18.000 pages







### 2. Two SKOS vocabularies are extracted from the text. Concepts link into the text and to other datasets in the Linked Data Cloud



### 3. The VK Linked Data provides enriched access to the text, supporting historical research and unexpected re-use.
